for hybridisation of Narcissus*

After a challenging season, when we were unable to make our usual show entries for family reasons, Nial Watson and his wife Hilary made their first trip to the ADS Convention in Pittsburgh P.A., where they managed to keep the name of Ballydorn before the ADS with a trade stand of 80 of our cultivars. Nial also put up a few flowers of his own with great success. Their daughter Alice's top class flower, Brian Duncan N. Notre Dame, won the Junior Section.

We have named a few cultivars, including N. Peggy's Gift, named to celebrate the long service given by Peggy Macneale to the ADS and the gift to her of the main stock of the cultivar. Also, we include two interesting cultivars of high colour and form, which measure intermediate classification here, but may be larger elsewhere under trial.

The N. Portsalon has been praised as a seedling in California and in England where it joined the National Collection of daffodils, grown under the care of Martin Harwood, its Director

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CHOICE NEW DAFFODILS

ARRANGEMENT OF LIST, AND CODING SYSTEM

The list has been arranged in alphabetical order with the Division and Classification of each cultivar shown in the margin. The classification is in accordance with the Revised System adopted by the R. H. S. Colours are abbreviated as follows:

w - white or whitish; g - green; y - yellow; p - pink; o - orange; r - red.

For the purpose of description, the daffodil flower is divided into perianth, and corona. The perianth is described by the first letter following the number of the Division to which the cultivar belongs.

The corona is treated as having three zones: An eye zone, a mid-zone and an edge or rim. The description of the corona is separated from the description of the perianth by hyphen and the letter then following the hyphen describes the corona colour starting with the eye zone. If however the corona is of a single colour, only a single letter of the colour code is used to describe it.
